RE: COVID-19 vaccination programme for children aged 12-17 in schools

We are writing to let you know, following the successful delivery of the COVID-19 vaccination in schools, this programme will complete on 14 Jan 2022.

We would like to express our thanks to the Education Authority and schools for their support and assistance provided in the roll-out of this programme.

If your child was unable to receive their first COVID-19 vaccine through this programme and you would like them to benefit from this vaccination, appointments are available at local Health and Social Care Trust COVID-19 vaccination clinics.

Children aged 12-17 are now eligible to receive a second dose of the COVID-19 vaccine, 12 weeks after their first dose (or 8 weeks for those in a clinical risk group, or who are a household contact of someone who is immunosuppressed).
