Roles of Staff on the Ladder of Referral

Form Teacher

The form teacher is the first staff member parents / carers should contact when you have a query or need assistance. Please contact the school office and they will send a message to the form teacher asking them to contact you as soon as they can.

Year Head / Head of Department

Your Year Head is the person who oversees your son's year group. This is the second person you should contact if your son's form teacher has not been able to resolve your query. If you have a curricular concern, then please speak to the Head of Department

Head of School

The Head of School is available to assist parents when their query has not been resolved following contact with your son's Form Teacher and Head of Year.

Vice Principals (Pastoral or Curriculum)

The Vice Principals are available to assist parents when their query has not been resolved following contact with your son's Form Teacher, Head of Year and Head of School.

Learning Support (SENCo)

Mrs Barr is the Learning Support Coordinator (SENCo).

Safeguarding and Child Protection Team

Designated teacher in charge of Child Protection

The Pastoral Vice Principal is Mrs Fiona Crookes. She is the teacher in charge of Child Protection. She has an office in the main school building on the Q2 corridor. Mrs Crookes teaches Religion.

Deputy designated teacher in charge of Child Protection

There are three Deputy Designated Teachers for Child Protection:
