Please find important information outlined below regarding the distribution and collection of your son's forthcoming exam results.

Exam	Year Group	Day/date	Arrangements
A2	14	Thursday 17 th August 2023	Students can log on to CCEA to access their results (results for other Award Bodies must be collected from the school).
AS	13		Students collect their results between 09.00 – 10.00 at the Mobile classroom at the front of the school building.
GCSE	12	Thursday 24 th August 2023	Students collect their results between 09.00 – 09.30am in the school canteen. <u>No parental cars permitted on site</u> Parking on site is reserved only for parents/ guardians attending Induction sessions.
GCSE	10	Thursday 24 th August 2023	Students collect their results between 09.00 – 09.30am in the school canteen. <u>No parental cars permitted on site</u> Parking on site is reserved only for parents/ guardians attending Induction sessions.
GCSE	11	Thursday 24 th August 2023	Students collect their results between 10.00 – 10.30am in the school canteen. Parents of new Year 12s are <u>permitted to park</u> in the ER Yard to collect results in the canteen and then attend the parental induction in the school Assembly Hall.
