Monday 1 st September 2025	Classes begin for YEAR 8 PUPILS ONLY. 09.00 – 15.15	Pupils wear full uniform, breaktime tuckshop and lunch canteen facilities are available (Please ensure your son has credit on his ParentMail account if he requires this – Details on how to download the Parent Mail App to be sent in August)	Pupils finish at 15.15. Parents are not permitted to drive up the school lane.

Year 8 Induction and ER Camp:

- All pupils must attend <u>all Induction days</u>.
- Full uniform must be worn Tuesday 26th and Wednesday 27th. PE gear should be brought for the ER Camp sessions on Wednesday 27th, students will change from their full school uniform into sports gear before the camp begins. Pupils may wear PE gear to school on Thursday 28th August.
- Please bring a break and a packed lunch (including a bottle of water) each day as there will be no canteen facilities. Break only is required on Thursday 29th August.
- Pupils should bring wired earphones for the PTE and PTM assessments taking place on Tuesday 26th and Wednesday 27th August.

All parents (including new applicants) are required to apply online via EA website https://www.eani.org.uk/financial-help/free-school-meals-uniform-grants . If your son is entitled to Free School Meals, it is very important that you apply for these whether or not your son intends availing of the service.
